

NEW BOSTON FORESTRY COMMITTEE  
Minutes of Meeting – April 4, 2011

ATTENDEES: Kim DiPietro, Tim Trimbur, Karl Heafield, Dave Allen, Nancy Loddengaard, and Glen Dickey who is considering becoming a member.

The meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm.

REVIEW OF MARCH MINUTES: Approved as written.

TREASURER'S REPORT: \$15,820.47

#### OLD BUSINESS

Johnson Lot- We are awaiting Dennis McKenny to notify Tim when he is ready to mark trees for the set amount of \$1000.

Lydia Dodge Lot West – The committee approved \$300 to cover the cost of granite for the bridge. Dave to look and see about the granite. He also suggested having the town use their equipment to set the granite. Kim to talk to Gerry Cornet. We may also need some 1 ½” crushed gravel to set the granite on. Kim continuing to try to find the reflective tape.

O'Rourke Lot – Dave mentioned they could use a bridge of two trees lashed together to cross the brook.

Trail Maps – Kim talked to Laura Bernard and the Conservation Committee. They are doing a representative picture and a written description. Karl will work on Marvel, Kim will do Lydia Dodge East and West, Dave to provide a map of O'Rourke. They may combine Colby, Siemeze and Follansbee together.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Intents to Cut - None to review.

Sherburne Lot Trail and Culvert – Tim met with Vanessa Burns. It is considered a permanent crossing, and it is a \$200 application fee. One form goes to the town and it goes through Conservation and the 2<sup>nd</sup> form goes to the state. Plan is to take a site walk to see where the best location for the culvert would be.
