

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

June 1, 1978

Present were Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada, Thomas Mansfield and Betty Hooper.

Mr. Mark Genest and Mr. Surette, members of the Goffstown graduation class, were in to ask for permission to hold a senior class party on June 23 on land owned by Laban Todd on Colburn and Middle Branch Road.

Permission was granted with stipulations described in a letter to Mr. Todd.

Diane Crawford came in for an estimate of her property taxes for 1978.

The Selectmen met with the newly appointed ^{"Town Hall} ~~stump~~ committee."

Betsy explained the reason for forming this committee is through the concern of town citizens feeling the need of better care and repairs to the town hall. Mr. Towne felt this committee should bring the hall up to standard and see that it is kept at that level. The committee hopes to spear-head an attempt to make all organizations using it aware of the necessity to respect this building by keeping it clean. Roland explained that the Selectmen have had necessary repairs to the hall in the past, but not always things that show. He advised that with any contracts involved with repairs to the town hall will be signed by the Selectmen. One Selectman will be appointed to act as liason to the committee. Roland moved, seconded by Gus, that the above-mentioned persons be appointed as the "Town Hall Committee".

Dotty Fillmore will check into enlisting a CEPA person and also which fees to be charged ~~by~~ for public use. The subject of insurance was raised. Roland assured everyone that the building is amply insurance.

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New Boston's share of CETA funds is \$60,000. The committee plans to ask for three workers, one of which will act as supervisor.

Roland listed the following projects that the Selectmen have planned for revovation to the town hall: paint, new doors, furnace, window sashes, new emergency lights, new fire extinguishes, and ceiling lights.

THE Committee plans to request from Federal funds, the full \$60,000. We will have from 6 months to 1 year to finish our project.
