

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

June 8, 1978

Present were Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

Dorothy Fillmore brought in forms to submit to the government for CETA funds application. We are requesting \$60,000.

John LaPlant, new owner of Burnham Fuel Co. (accompanied by Richard Reynolds) wished to inquire about the outcome of a building permit submitted by Burnham Fuel some time ago and referred to the Board of Adjustment. Mr. LaPlant also wanted to know if he needed a building permit to increase the tank capacity on the site. Roland read him a letter which had been sent to the Town of New Boston advising of the decision of the Board of Adjustment on the case. Roland felt he should apply for a building permit to expand.

Karen Craven was the only applicant to the position of Deputy Town Clark. The Selectmen appointed her to the position.

Roland Sallada presented the Gold Headed Boston Post Cane to Artemus Boulter today. Mr. Boulter is a resident of the Masonic Home in Manchester N. H.

At the first part of the evening, the Selectmen, accompanied by Chief Ballou, inspected the John Winslow property for unregistered cars. They found 10 cars unregistered, therefore was found in violation of the Junk Car Ordinance. A court case against Mr. Winslow will be held on June 20, at the Goffstown District Court.
