George Hawkins came in in behalf of Mr. Nick Vardaro and Mr. & Mrs. David Inman who are interested in purchasing the Dunbar land now owned by the town. This town land cannot be specifically located and there is much discussion as to the cost of purchase by the Inmans. The property is located in the middle of Mr. Vardaro's land which he hoped to subdivide ~~xxx~~ and give to the Inmans. The Selectmen planned to put this Dunbar land up for auction placing a minimum price of \$500 on it. The Inmans feel this is too much. It was Mr. Hawkins opinion that it is illegal for the town to set a minimum fee. The Selectmen will look into this.
