

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

June 29, 1978

Present were Thomas Mansfield and Betty Hooper.

A building permit was issued to Richard Turosh to build a garage.

Tom met with Police Chief John Ballou and members of the Playground Committee relative to car congestion during the July 4 celebration and the parking problem. Present were Chief Ballou, Roy and Jean Lowell, Larry and Cathy Strausbaugh, Linda Rollins and Leon Daniels. Tom explained he had received complaints on the blocking of Meetinghouse Hill by cars. Chief Ballou expressed the opinion that he thinks the whole celebration should be held at the 4-H grounds.

Some of the sites available for parking will be at Leon Daniel's garage, Dan McCreary's back lot, the 4-H grounds, the school grounds and the field off of Molly Stark Lane.

It was agreed that Meetinghouse Hill and Molly Stark Lane will be closed off from 6 to 9pm. Saw-housed will be placed at the entrances and will be manned by the baseball team. The parking lots will have a 50¢ fee.

Cathy received permission to a key to the Town Hall, as a group will be camping in the playground July 3 and will need bathroom facilities.
