Mr. & Mrs. Russell Freeman would like to created a pond and pasture. In order to do this they would like to remove gravel which requires a permit. Usually a gravel permit requires a restoration bond, topographic map, and hearing of which the Freeman's are request a waiver. Mrs. Freeman read a letter of their proposal. The above residents were concerned about the additional traffic over the four (4) year period. Mr. James Smith questioned who determines if the amount of gravel requested is *on to 1* correct. The Selectmen will consider the gravel permit and get back to the Mr. & Mrs. Russell Freeman.

9:30 PM Mr. & Mrs. Arthur Jeck came in to review with the Selectmen their request to open a automotive repair business at their residence. Selectmen will review their request and get back to them.
