Present were Selectmen Olson, Mansfield, Dodge and secretary.

- 7:10 Tim Cady from GZA came in to review the bid package for covering the landfill. Notice for the bid will appear in the Goffstown News November 23, 1988. The bid package will be available at the Town Office and GZA on November 28, 1988. There will be a on site inspection November 30, 1988 and all bids will be in by December 5, 1988.
- 7:55 Darlene Goodin and Pam Strand representing the Cub Scouts came in for permission to sell Christmas trees in the Town parking lot. Scouts have liability coverage through the Daniel Webster Council in Manchester. Trees will be kept at John Riendeau's property on Beard Road. Trees will be sold Friday, December 9 6PM-9PM, Saturday 8AM-9PM, and Sunday noon-4PM.
- 8:15 Jay Ranfos, Precision Press came in with a bid to print the Town Reports. He started his business in June of 1988. His quote for 106 pages, 1200 books \$2,950. For a small size book (8½x5½) \$2,670.00. In order for the Town to receive the books by February 24, 1989 he would have to receive the last of the information by February 13, 1989 with the exception of the warrant by February 15, 1989. Mr. Ranfos expects payment thirty days after completion. Selectmen will go on location November 28, 1988 to see his facilities.
