Present were Selectmen Olson, Mansfield, Dodge and secretary.

- 7:30 Alex Noftsger came in to discuss building a air strip on his property for his own personal use. The air strip would be approximately 1,500 feet long and 100 feet wide. The letter Mr. Noftsger received from Department of Transportation was sent to the New Boston Tracking Station to inform them that an airstrip may be constructed.
- 8:10 Donald Lyons, Victor Ponpor came in to discuss him operating a auto repair business at his home. Mr. Lyons has requested a Dealer's Inspection Station from the State of N.H. Mr. Lyons has not gone to the necessary boards to be granted this request. Selectmen will go on location January 9, 1989 at 6:30 PM to inspect the location. They will then recommend what will be necessary for him to qualify under our zoning regulations.

Selectman Willard Dodge made motion not to continue hauling New Boston trash to Bennington, N.H. but to sign a contract to haul to Bethlehem, N.H. Seconded by Thomas Mansfield. Selectmen voted unanimously.
