

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING -02-20-89


Present for the 7:00 pm meeting were Selectmen Willard Dodge and Theodore Olson, Sandra Gendron took minutes. Weekly checks were signed, a contract with Brent Armstrong was signed for the painting and staining at the Town Hall to continue the renovation to office space, the contract was signed with New England Telephone for the installation on Intellipath Centrex in the newly renovated office space. It was noted that financial assistance for the Lennon family on River Road had been reviewed by Sandra Gendron and at this time they could continue on their own.

Representatives from the Recreation Commission and the Junior Athletic League met with the Selectmen at 7:30 to discuss the Athletic League becoming a part of the Recreation Commission. It was agreed by all present including the Selectmen that this would be a positive move benefiting all in the Town of New Boston. The two groups will now meet and will set-up an organizational structure and present this to the Selectmen for approval. Discussion ensued as to the conditions of present playing fields and safety improvements that should be made and what projects might be pursued to raise monies for these projects, and lastly, what sites might be available for future playing fields.

Steve Allen was in and agreement was reached between he and the Selectmen with regard to the 1989 assessing in New Boston. Steve will meet all the needs of New Boston for a flat fee of \$15,000.00, \$10,000.00 to be paid when the pick-up work and new construction is assessed, the remaining \$5,000.00 will be paid by December 31, 1989. He will assess all the new subdivisions, represent New Boston if necessary, in tax court, and will figure all current land use penalties as needed.

The two Selectmen present agreed that the Town would join the N. H. Health Trust and all Town health benefits would be generated from this Trust. A meeting had been held between a representative of the Trust and those receiving health benefits from the Town, it was agreed by all that the Blue-Cross Comp S plan would serve everyone's needs very well and would be economical for the Town.
