

be made, Bruce would prefer to be a regular member as opposed to an alternate.

Lloyd Hill was the next person interviewed for the ZBA. The Selectmen explained what the duties of a member of this board would entail. Mr. Hill gave a brief history of himself including his military background and his present work in the field of financial planning. He stated an interest in working on the finance committee in addition to any resulting appointment from this interview. The Selectmen agreed that work on both committees would not be a conflict.

Oscar Peters was the third interview. He also gave his background having moved to New Boston after living 25 years in the Goffs Falls area of Manchester. He is retired and has time to give. He also was explained the duties of the ZBA and when asked replied that he did not care if he were a regular or alternate member as opposed to Mr. Hill's desire to be a regular member.

At the conclusion of the interviews the Selectmen voted to appoint Bruce Fillmore as an alternate to the Planning Board advancing Brent Armstrong to the position of regular member. On the Board of Adjustment the Selectmen voted to advance Bill Hebert to a regular member replacing Yvonne Gomes, Lloyd Hill was appointed as a regular member replacing retiring Don Byam, term to expire in 1990 and Oscar Peters was appointed as an alternate to the ZBA. Willard Dodge would contact William Forest who had not been an active alternate member of the ZBA that his appointment would not be renewed. Copies of these appointments were sent to all and William Brendle, Chairman of ZBA was notified of these appointments.

The subject of temporary trailer permits was discussed and the following will be the procedure followed when such a permit is requested. A readable sketch will be provided showing the property layout with the temporary trailer location in relationship to the proposed future homesite. An abutters list will be provided and a hearing using the words "temporary trailer" will be scheduled in the same manner as in the past for trailer hearings.


