

Selectmen's Meeting - June 19, 1989

Present for the meeting were Selectmen Dodge and Johnston, with Sandra Gendron taking minutes. Selectman Mansfield was out of Town.

Lee Murray Road Agent was in for his regular meeting with the Selectmen. He was asked by the two Selectmen to erect a "deaf person" sign in the area of the Charles Hoyt home on Lyndeboro Road.

Lee discussed driveways that did not conform with the permit and have now been paved. An example of such a driveway is the first house on the left on Foxberry Lane. There are several others that will be a problem from a drainage standpoint especially during the winter months. Some of these might be reviewed next Monday evening (6-26-89) when the Selectmen are making the rounds of various projects with the Road Committee and the Road Agent. Most of the problems appear to become more evident when a driveway is paved.


There was general discussion of the progress of the committee established to look into the feasibility of moving the Babson Memorial Monument. Selectman Johnston represents the Board of Selectmen on that committee.

Discussion ensued on a letter received by the Planning Board from Hall Bros. Construction regarding what they considered the unattractiveness of their cistern and how this might be improved upon and still meet the requirements of the Fire Department. The Selectmen agreed that a barrier was needed at the front and the addition of loam, grass and shrubs would make the area more appealing to the eye. They will encourage the Fire Department to meet with the Hall's and hopefully a mutual agreement can be arrived at.

Selectman Dodge reported that he had spoken to Ronald Sizemore and the material that the Planning Board was requesting would be presented midweek. This information would be passed along to the Planning Board to alleviate their concerns.

All business having been acted on, checks signed and the mails reviewed, the meeting was adjourned at 9:10 pm.
