Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

March 4, 1996

A regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Pimenta.

The Board of Selectmen approved the Selectmen's Meeting minutes from February 26, 1996.

Town Moderator Lee Nyquist met with the Board of Selectmen at 7:30 p.m. to discuss preparations for 1996 Town Meeting. The Selectmen reviewed the 1996 Town Warrant with Moderator Nyquist, as well as the rules and procedures which will be followed on March 12 and March 16, 1996.

Town Administrator Selig informed the Board of Selectmen that no employees had opted to take advantage of the BC/BS Comp500 health insurance policy which the Selectmen were going to propose at 1996 Town Meeting. The Board therefore decided to drop this option from its proposed cafeteria program.

The Selectmen signed a letter addressed to Marie Valandro of 39 Summit Drive concerning a stone wall which currently lies in the Town's right-of-way. The Board has asked Mrs. Valandro to have the wall removed due to safety and drainage concerns by June 1, 1996.

Town Administrator Selig informed the Board that the N.H. Department of Revenue Administration had set New Boston's 1995 Equalization Ratio at 101%.

Chairman Pimenta updated the Board of Selectmen on what had transpired at the February 27, 1996, Planning Board meeting.

Town Administrator Selig discussed a recent N.H. Board of Tax and Land Appeals decision concerning Albert Jr. & Jeannette Couture v. Town of New Boston (Map 002, Lot 138-001; 110 Riverdale Road, New Boston). The BTLA ruled in favor of the Town of New Boston.

The Board of Selectmen reviewed a letter from Jim and Pat Hansen of 31 Briar Hill Road concerning Rose Meadow Farm. The Selectmen asked Mr. Selig to distribute a copy of the letter to the Police Department and Planning Office to determine if the Town could be of assistance in the matter.

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The Board of Selectmen reviewed a letter from the New Boston Forestry Committee concerning proposed renovations to the Town's ballfield located on Old Coach Road in New Boston.

The Board reviewed an anonymous letter written to Recreation Commission Chairman Karen Hall concerning Recreation Director Sandra Gallup.

Mr. Selig informed the Selectmen that the NHMA Property-Liability Insurance Trust has a new program whereby the Town's Police Department policies and procedures could be reviewed by the Trust. The Board asked Mr. Selig to pass this notification along to Police Chief McLaughlin for his review.

The Board reviewed payroll and accounts payable checks.

Chairman Pimenta signed pistol permits.

The Board reviewed and/or signed other miscellaneous correspondence and materials.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
