# "Preparing Your Source Separated Recyclables"

## "Recycle by The Number" It's Easy!!!!

<p><b>#1</b> <u>Glass</u> "Anything That Shatters"</p>	<p>Glass Bottles (any color!), Window Glass (Removed From Frame) Ceramics, Cups, Plates, Plates, Mirrors, Pottery, Clean Tile. Broken Glass and Ceramics Too!</p> <p><b>"Please No Fluorescent bulbs or windshield glass."</b></p>
<p><b>#2</b> <u>Aluminum</u> "Beverage Cans Only"</p>	<p>Aluminum cans only</p> <p><b>"No foil paper or Pet Food Cans"</b></p>
<p><b>#3</b> <u>Tin Cans</u></p>	<p>Tin Cans, Metal Lids, Pet Food Cans, Aerosol Cans, Paint Cans Aluminum foil, Foil food trays.</p> <p><b>Aerosol and Paint Cans <u>MUST</u> be empty!</b></p>
<p><b>#4</b> <u>Cardboard</u></p>	<p>Corrugated Cardboard Packing boxes</p> <p><b>2 Flat layers and a wavy inner layer Any size, Any Color, Tape OK, Shiny finish OK, Printed on OK.</b></p>
<p><b>#5 &amp; #6</b> Paper Mixed Paper News Paper "If it rip's or tear's"</p>	<p>News Paper &amp; Inserts, Magazines, Catalogs, <u>ALL PAPER</u>, All mail, Junk Mail, Scrap Paper, Envelopes, Egg cartons, Phone books, Construction Paper, Cartons (milk, juice, freezer), Chip Board (Example: Cereal, Shoe, Pasta, Toy, Tissue Boxes), brown bags, paperback books, <u>Shredded paper (ok to leave in bag!), If it rips or tears we want it!!!</u></p> <p><b>* No foil finish cartons, No plastic lined bags,*</b> <b>Remove or Tear Off Labels If Concerned About Security</b></p>
<p>P L A S T I C</p> <p><b>#7</b> HDPE #2 BOTTLE</p> <p><b>#8</b> PETE #1 BOTTLE</p> <p>CHECK FOR THE NECK AND SCRAP THE CAP BOTTLE RECYCLING</p>	<p>Opaque or Solid Colored Plastic Bottles Soap, Milk, Dish Washer, Laundry Detergent....</p> <p><b>"If You <u>Cannot</u> See Through It" "Please Remove Caps"</b> <b>Please discard Oil and Antifreeze Containers</b></p> <p>Clear or See Through Plastic Bottles Water, Soda, Salad Dressing.....</p> <p><b>"If you <u>Can See</u> Through It" "Please Remove Caps"</b></p>

### "Items that should NOT be in Recycling"

**"Garbage"**- Including food waste, diapers, motor oil bottles, antifreeze bottles, pool chemicals, kitty litter, food soiled paper, sharps, vacuum bags etc.

### "Items Not Allowed in the Garbage"

**Lawn & Yard Waste**- Compost It!

**Dirt & Rocks**- (Our waste goes to an Incinerator to be burned.)

**Electronics**- Anything with a plug must be recycled

**Batteries**- All rechargeable batteries (Automotive, Ni-cad, Watch, Cell phone, power tool) must be recycled.  
(Standard household Batteries go in the garbage.)

**Paint**- Please Ask Attendant for handling instructions.

**Medicines**- Call Pharmacy about proper disposal and handling methods and take back programs.

**"Please Watch for Local Collection Events for "Controlled and Prescribed Drugs"**

**Household Hazardous Waste**- We **CANNOT** Accept Any Hazardous Waste; Paints, pool chemicals, pesticides, solvents, stains, ammunition, gasoline or any asbestos containing items..... Please Ask Attendant for Assistance.

**Demolition**- Household deconstruction, carpets, windows, fiberglass, drywall, roofing, painted or treated wood.

**Metal**- All metal and metal containing items are to be recycled.

### Fee Based Items:

Demolition, Refrigerators, Air conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Electronics, Auto Batteries, Passenger Tires

**Small Volume Residential Generated "Non Commercial" Universal Waste Items**

Used Oil for Recycle, Rechargeable Batteries, Waste Oil for Recycle, Anti-freeze, Florescent Light Bulbs, CFL's

**Fines for Illegal Dumping up to \$150.00**
